Citywide Boat Ramp Replacement Program PH III -City of Sunrise, FL City of West Palm Beach Clear Lake Trail



Engenuity Group, Inc. Provided a Topographic survey of (9) boat ramp sites for the City of Sunrise, FL. At each boat ramp site (2) vertical and (2) horizontal controls were established, all surface features including drainage structures, drainage apron, culvert, trees, sidewalk, swale, edge of pavement, landscaping, rip rap, valve covers, manholes, and guardrail, etc., and survey drawings were prepared utilizing AutoCAD 2016.



The City of West Palm Beach requested a Topographic & Tree survey for Clear Lake Trail in West Palm Beach, FL from Engenuity Group.
